3. *Health Insurance - The student has adequate health and medical insurance; and
4. Validation of I-20 – I will verify the student's actual physical arrival on campus and validation of the I-20 at the International Student and Scholar Center.

In return for these affirmations, I request that the International Student and Scholar Center remove the "International Hold" from this student's file so that this student may register for classes as soon as s/he has been admitted to Weber State University.

I understand that if all of these conditions are not met, the following consequences could occur:

1. The student may be deregistered from classes;
2. The student may be required to register for LEAP and ESL classes; and/or
3. The student may have his/her I-20 cancelled and be deported from the United States.
