Glen David Gold (born 1964) is an American author, known as the writer of [*Carter Beats the Devil*](#) and [*Sunnyside*](#). *Carter Beats the Devil* is a fictionalized biography of [Charles Joseph Carter](#) (1874–1936), an American illusionist performing from c. 1900 to 1936. His second novel, [*Sunnyside*](#), was published in 2009. Short stories of his—including "The Tears of [Squonk](#)"—have appeared in a number of issues of [McSweeney's](#).

Gold received his BA from [Wesleyan University](#) and his MFA in creative writing at the [University of California at Irvine](#).
