

RICHARD BAUSCH

Richard Bausch was born in Ft. Benning, Georgia. He is the author of eleven novels and eight collections of stories. His novel, *Peace*, was awarded the 2010 Dayton International Literary Peace Prize.

He has won two National Magazine Awards, a Guggenheim Fellowship, and a Lila-Wallace Reader's Digest Fund Writer's Award, the Award of the American Academy of Arts and Letters, and the 2004 PEN/Malamud Award for Excellence in the Short Story. In 1995 he was elected to the Fellowship of Southern Writers. In 1999 he signed on as co-editor, with RV Cassill, of *The Norton Anthology of Short Fiction*. Since Cassill's passing, in 2002, he is the sole editor of the anthology. Richard is the 2013 Winner of the REA award for Short Fiction. Bausch is currently a professor at Chapman University in Orange, California.
