Justification	Exams and writing assignments require students to accurately define and identify concepts covered in the text, articles, and class discussion.	Writing assignments, discussions, and class projects demonstrate students' knowledge by requiring them to apply the concepts covered in class to their own life.	Writing assignments and in-class discussion require students to justify the application of scientific methodologies and conclusions.	Writing assignments and in-class discussion constitute 50% of the grade for this course. Additionally, 50% of each exam is comprised of essay questions.
