

GPA Rating Scale

Applicants are evaluated using a 100 point system: 30 points maximum for GPA (cumulative) 2.75 or above (or at least a 3.0 for the last 30 semester hours, whichever is highest); 30 points maximum for the Collegiate Assessment of Academic Proficiency (CAAP); 40 points maximum for admission interview. Please refer to the table below:
