A paper written in APA/MLA style and oral report are required at the end of the term. Prerequisite: WS1500 and faculty mentor permission.		
Guidelines If you plan to do directed readings, you will need to accomplish the following. In addition to what is listed below, you must write a paragraph explaining your general topic, what you plan to focus on, and the specific points you plan to address. This must be turned in to the faculty mentor, along with this form, prior to starting your directed readings. Without both of these, you will not receive a grade for directed readings. Consistent with University guidelines, you should expect to work approximately 3 hours per week per credit hour. If you take WS 4830 for one credit hour for a 14 week semester, you should expect to devote a minimum of 42 hours.
